- Print this template onto thin card (or if your prefer A4 paper and then stick onto card) *see below
- 2. Draw round it on to fabric to create the bunting flags We would like you to **re-cycle** material from old shirts, sheets, table cloths, etc.
- Cut out on red, white or blue fabric or any patterned fabric you feel is suitable.
 To make the edge look attractive, you could use pinking shears if you have them.
- 4. The top portion is the flap which will fold over the tape to string the bunting flags together. Decorate below the line shown
- 5. Decorate the front as you wish on the bottom portion. You could:
 - a. Use fabric paint with a stamp made from a potato
 - b. Glue or sew on ribbon, felt, fabric or lace
 - c. Use fabric pens to draw a picture
 - d. Embroider it.
