

NATIONAL ARBORETUM AND HILL CLOSE GARDENS

SATURDAY 30TH JULY 2022

National Arboretum: located near Burton-on-Trent, this is the UK's year-round centre of Remembrance which is home to over 400 symbolic memorials. Situated across a 150-acre site, amongst 25,000 maturing trees, the memorials pay tribute to those who have served our country, including the Armed Forces, civilian and emergency services, and UK charities. The Arboretum features a contemporary visitor centre, events building, woodland walks, land train tours, exhibitions, restaurant, coffee shop and gift shop.

On arrival we will be given tea, coffee and biscuits which are included in the cost. There is plenty to see at the 150 acre site but to save us the effort of walking round it all, we are booked on the land train at 12 noon. This 50 minute journey features a pre-recorded commentary and takes visitors through the grounds and the memorials along the way.



You can enjoy lunch in their restaurant which serves hot meals, snacks and drinks, or bring your own picnic to eat in one of their picnic areas. There is also a coffee shop and naturally a gift shop where you can enjoy some retail therapy before we move on to our next visit of the day.

Hill Close Gardens: a unique chance to visit sixteen rare survivals of Victorian pleasure gardens within the town of Warwick. Each has been restored to capture the personalities and planting of their original owners and includes a mixture of fruit, flowers, a grassed area and heritage vegetables. Hill Close Gardens have an extremely wide range of horticulture with many rare and ‘at risk’ plants, particularly in plot 17 and the Victorian glasshouse. There are 8 historic Victorian summer houses.



You can visit their Visitor centre with information about the history of the gardens on touchscreens. Cakes and cream teas, if you have room, are available in their Tearoom. You have yet another opportunity for retail therapy in the giftshop which offers garden-themed merchandise as well as plants, seasonal produce and fruit grown in the Plant Nursery.

Introduction

Not only do these trips enable us to be inspired by beautiful gardens, they are also a great way for members to meet old friends and make new ones. The outings and the gardens we visit are chosen to appeal to all our members.

Members are encouraged to make suggestions for visits to the CSGGA committee.

Booking Information

Please complete the relevant booking form printed at the back of this booklet and send it to the organiser. Payment is via online banking or you can attach a cheque. If you are unable to print the form, send an email, or write all the information requested on a separate piece of paper to accompany your cheque. This information will be taken on the trip and destroyed afterwards; we will not be storing it electronically unless you send it via email.

We will not cash any cheques until an outing has sufficient support. Cheques are not usually cashed until shortly before the outing takes place unless payment needs to be made in advance.

Members are allowed two places per household on a first-come, first-served basis and will be given priority for two weeks after the details have been announced.

All non-members, whether coming as guests of members or independently, will be charged a supplementary amount.

If places are still available after the members' priority booking period, members will be notified and offered additional places. Places may also be advertised through the village email newsletter and to other garden clubs to ensure that the outing is viable.

If an outing is oversubscribed, we will make every effort to obtain further places but if this is not possible we will keep a waiting list.

The closing date for bookings will usually be 14 days before the outing unless otherwise stated, but please contact the organiser to check if any further places are available after this.

Cancellations and no shows

Payment is non-refundable unless a substitution can be found. Please note that, for security reasons, the owners of some gardens require a list of names of those visiting their gardens. Where this is the case, it is unlikely that we will be able to make substitutions.

We are not able to offer a refund to anyone who does not arrive in time for the coach to depart.

If a garden visit is cancelled or postponed due to circumstances beyond the control of CSGGA, then we would hope to be able to reimburse the full amount of the outing, but this cannot be guaranteed if we are unable to obtain refunds from third parties.
