First leaf of this year

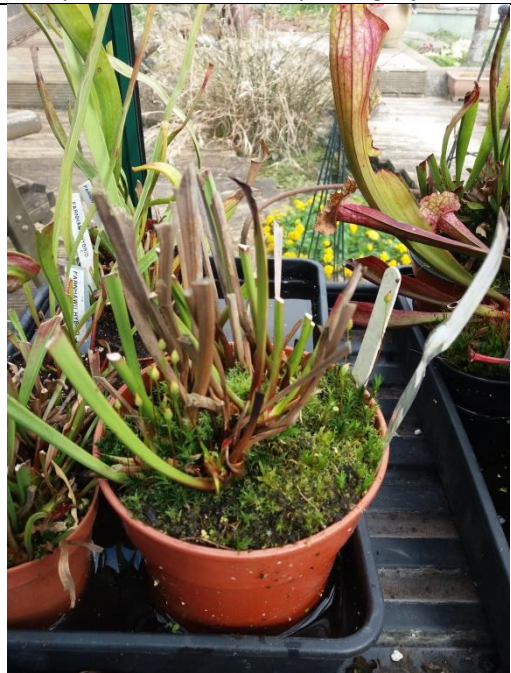
Last year's stems

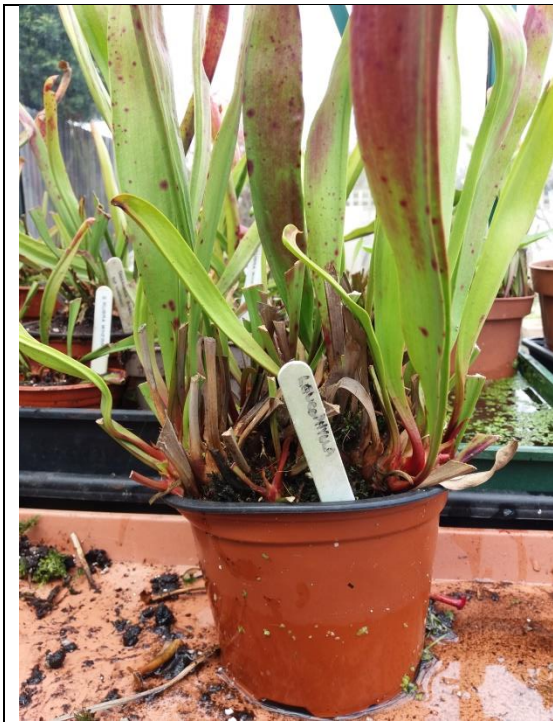
You can see old stems from 2 years ago

This plant didn't need repotting. I just tidied it up by removing the dead wood from 2 years ago.





My *Sarracenia leucophylla* needed repotting as it was splitting its pot. So I divided it up and now have 4 *Sarracenia leucophylla*
